- Girl Bowlers will lead off in Match Play. 2.
- Check-in time is 30 minutes before starting time.
- 4. Bowlers will receive warm-up only at the start of the Tournament.
- First ball thrown with a sub will replace absent bowler. If no sub is available and the absent bowler arrives, the late bowler will be credited zero pins for each frame missed.
- USBC Rules and Regulations will govern this Tournament. 6.
- Starting lane positions will be drawn upon check-in. NO PRACTICE WILL BE ALLOWED ON HIS/HER STARTING PAIR.
- Each Team is responsible for turning in and picking up their score sheets and all score sheets must be signed and turned in.
