Boys and girls will compete in separate divisions – all competition on <u>ACTUAL BASIS</u>. All contestants will bowl a four (4) games qualifying round, moving after each game. The field will then be cut to the top twelve (12) boys and top eight (8) girls or the top ½ of the field, whichever is higher, for the next three (3) games of qualifying (total of 24 is the highest amount of combined qualifiers). Warm-ups shall consist of two (2) balls on each lane prior to the start of the tournament. Total scores from first 4 games will carry over to the next three (3) games. There will be a short break after the first four games to tally scores and prior to the three (3) games each qualifier will be allowed one (1) ball on each lane. The top eight (8) boys and girls will then continue in a bracket style two-game single elimination format until one bowler remains in each bracket. The two-game portion will be bowled as a match play format with the higher seed choosing which lane he/she will start for the first game.

Awards will be awarded to the top three (3) boys and girls, High Qualifier (Boy and Girl), and High Game (Boy and Girl). USBC Rules will be followed. Score sheets shall be signed and added correctly before being turned in.

Rules and Regulations

- Lansing Match Play is open to any youth bowler participation is a USBC sanctioned youth league at the
 following centers: Char Lanes, City Limits, City Limits East, Red Wing Lanes, Riverbend Bowl, Royal Scot
 Golf & Bowl, The Bowling Alley, and Wagon Wheel Lanes. Youth bowlers shall not more than 20 years of
 age as of August 1st of the current bowling season. Bowler must have an average of at least 15 games during
 the current season in the centers listed.
- 2. The tournament will begin at the time printed on the entry blank.
- 3. Entry forms must be filled out legibly and money or check must accompany entry.
- '4. All score sheets will be signed. If you give yourself too many pins, you may be disqualified; if you deprive yourself of pins, scores will stand. All bowlers on the pair are responsible to verify scores of other bowlers on their pair of lanes.
- 5. Each bowler is responsible for turning in a signed copy of their score sheet to the tournament office.
- 6. No smoking, chewing tobacco, playing videos or use of bad language during the tournament.
- 7. Any MISCONDUCT SWEARING OR USE OF OBSCENE GESTURES will be fined \$5.00 for the first offense and \$5.00 for each offense thereafter, at the discretion of the any tournament offical. Bowlers can be disqualified and suspended from the remaining portion of the tournament.
- 8. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the settee area.
- Bowlers must declare their dominant hand on the entry and may not switch hands after their first ball of
 competition. NO SWITCHING! If an injury to a bowler occurs they may withdraw from the tournament.
- 10. All protests must be made by the bowlers. Outside objections will not be heard!
- 11. Alternate: Once they have thrown his/her first ball in the tournament, he/she will be considered in the tournament.
- 12. All award fees will be returned 100%.
- 13. Starting lane positions will be drawn upon check-in on Sunday. NO PRACTICE WILL BE ALLOWED ON HIS/HER STARTING LANE.
- 14. Acceptable Dress Code: Shirts with a collar or mock turtleneck with bowling logo and dress pants or skirts. No blue jeans, T-Shirts, sweatpants, shorts, jean skirts, or yoga pants. THIS DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
- 15. All balls used in tournament must meet USBC specifications. At no time may any foreign material be placed on the outer surface of the ball. Altering of the surface of a ball by the use of abrasives while bowling in a sanctioned competition is prohibited. If a particular ball is challenged and found to be illegal, the bowler will be disqualified from the tournament. No powder, rosin, or any other foreign materials are to be used on shoes.
- 16. Any disputes during tournament or exceptions to the above rules and regulations of the tournament will be resolved by the tournament committee.
