Each team shall consist of one girl and one boy. Competition will be on a scratch basis. All participants will bowl four (4) games in the Qualifying Round, moving after each game, skipping one pair to the right. After the Qualifying Round the following number of teams will go to the **double elimination match play baker format**; up to 23 entries - the top eight (8) teams, 24-31 entries - the top 12 teams, 32 or more entries - top 16 teams will advance. Each match will consist of two 2-person baker games. The winner is the team with the highest two game total pin fall. They winners will advance in the winner's bracket. The losers will be seeded in the loser's bracket and will bowl until a second match is lost. The winner of the loser's bracket must beat the winner of the winner's bracket twice to become champions. Awards will be given for the high game and high 4-game series in the qualifying round for boys and girls and for the 1st and 2nd place finishers in the tournament. **(For more tournament rules and awards please turn over the sheet.)**

Greater Lansing Youth Scratch Mixed Doubles Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Greater Lansing Area Scratch Mixed Doubles is open to any youth bowler participation is a USBC sanctioned youth league at the following centers: Char Lanes, City Limits, City Limits East, Red Wing Lanes, Riverbend Bowl, Royal Scot Golf & Bowl, The Bowling Alley, and Wagon Wheel Lanes. Youth bowlers shall not more than 20 years of age as of August 1st of the current bowling season. Bowler must have an average of at least 12 games during the current season in the centers listed.
2. Check-in time is 30 minutes before starting time.
3. Bowlers will receive 5 minutes of warm-up at the start of the first game of qualifying. Before the beginning of the 1" Match Play game, bowlers will receive one (1) ball on each lane.
4. First ball thrown with by a sub will replace absent bowler. If no sub is available and absent bowler arrives they receive a zero for each frame missed.
5. USBC rules and regulations will govern the tournament.
6. Starting lane positions will be drawn at check-in. No practice will be allowed on his/her starting lane.
7. Each team is responsible for turning in and picking up their score sheets and all score sheets much be turned in and signed.
8. During Match Play the girl bowler will lead off both games.
9. Bowlers must declare their dominant hand on the entry and may not switch hands after their first ball of competition. NO SWITCHING! If an injury to a bowler occurs they may withdraw from the tournament.
10. Any MISCONDUCT – SWEARING OR USE OF OBSCENE GESTURES – will be fined \$5.00 for the first offense and \$5.00 for each offense thereafter, at the discretion of any tournament official. Bowlers can be disqualified and suspended from the remaining portion of the tournament.
11. No playing of amusement games while bowling.
12. No smoking or use of tobacco products by bowlers or spectators during the tournament.
13. No drinking of alcoholic beverages on the concourse during the tournament.
14. All awards fees will be returned 100%.
15. Tournament awards will be given to the champions, runner-ups, highest 4-game series and highest game (for boy and girl) for the tournament.
16. Any disputes during tournament or exceptions to the above rules and regulations of the tournament will be resolved by the tournament committee.
17. You must be in bowling area when qualifiers are announced and be on your lanes when it is time to bowl or you will forfeit you spot.
18. Dress code will be strictly enforced. Acceptable attire includes Collared shirts or Mock shirts with a bowling logo and dress slacks, and or knee length skirts for girls. (No yoga pants or sweat pants)
